Monday 25th January – PE Session with Miss Gabriel

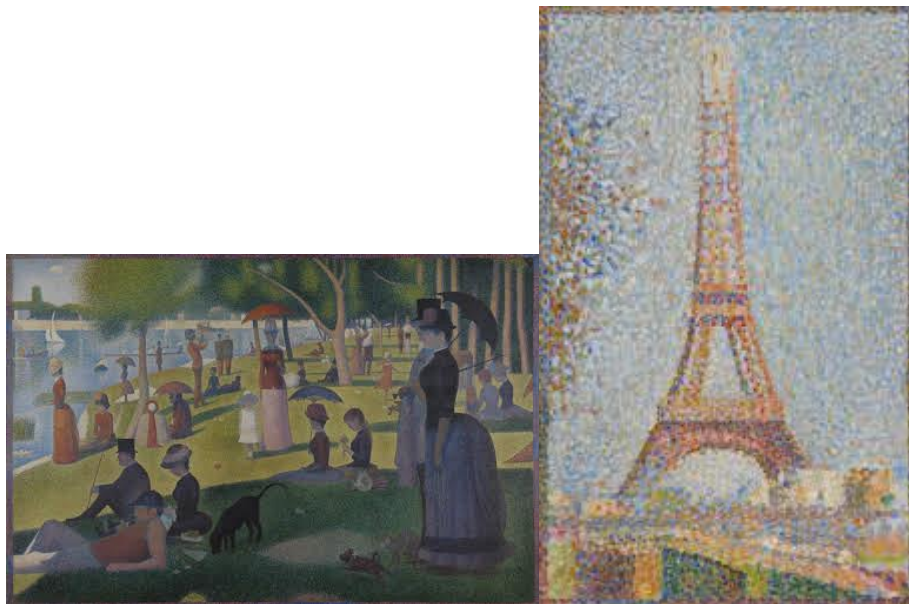
