### Our Academy's vision statement for P.E

### WHAT IS THE 'P.E AND SPORT PREMIUM FUNDING?'

'PE and Sport Premium Funding is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sports activities they offer their pupils.

Schools receive funding based on the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6.

Schools must spend the funding to improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils, but they are free to choose the best way of using the money'.

As a result of the additional funding the school aims to:

- Improve the quality of PE and sport in the Academy.
- Increase pupils' participation in PE and sport, so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

Target activity	Total	Impact
Supply cover, overtime and travel expenses to support PE Link Teacher to take pupils to sports fixtures and events: cross country, netball, football, rugby, athletics etc.	£2,600	Increase pupil participation rates in competitive sports events.

Great Britain Athletes visiting the school and the children receiving athlete training.	£1,000	All classes and the children at the school took part in an hour sport session with the athletes.
New Equipment indoor and outdoor	£300	New equipment for tennis, table tennis and outdoor sports. Children are able to play different sports on the playground as well as staying healthy with skipping ropes and bean games.

#### Outcome to date.

- All children offered at least 3 after school activity each week. 114 children out of 325 took part in an after-school sports club.
- Reaching two county final tournaments in Athletics and Cross-country.
- Hired a professional sport to take an after-school club linked to change for life. Aimed at improving obesity and confidence in sport.
- Increase in participation in all sport competitions- 38% in the whole school.
- 91% of swimmer leaving year 6 can swim the recommended 25m.
- Fitness and wellbeing in the morning with three-minute exercises.
